Our prayer is that this will be life changing! That we will be encouraged as believers to be bold about the truth we know and hold dear; that we will act and live our lives in complete worship to our Abba Father. We want to encourage the body to be unified together for His cause, and know what it means to be “doers of the word, not just hearers. That all men will know that we are His disciples who serve a living, active, loving Lord who desires us!”

In Greenville, music will be led by Out of the Box Music. Those participating are singers/songwriters Scott England, Corey Brown, Chris Huff, and confirming Jason Sartain. Local worship artists from the Greenville area are invited to contact Out of the Box Music for an opportunity to join forces for the night’s event. Throughout the night, pastors and leaders from the community will be leading attendees in prayer and reading scripture. The evening’s program also consists of prayer circles
