Celebrating its 4th Year, Worship on the Square Heads to the Road. The Evangelical Message of Worship on the Square is Heading to Greenville, SC and Plans to Rock out Centennial Park in Atlanta, GA for 2010.

Atlanta, GA January 10, 2010 - As the fourth and fifth event becomes shaped and groomed, Director, Debra Black continues to give God the glory and anticipates more road trips for Worship on the Square. Now under the non-profit, Out of the Box United, Black is currently working with corporate America for sponsorship. She is also teaming up with outreach organizations to provide a vision of "volunteerism," which according to Black is a lifestyle to fulfill as a form of worship. She continues, "The event was created to provide a gathering place and atmosphere of worship for people."

"Our prayer is that this won't be just another "worship event," where people come, feel like they experienced worship, got their fill and they are good till the next one. Our prayer is that this will be life changing! That we will be encouraged as believers to be bold about the truth we know and hold dear; that we will act and live our lives in complete worship to our Abba Father. We want to encourage the body to be unified together for His cause, and know what is means to be "doers of the word, not just hearers. That all men will know that we are His disciples who serve a living, active, loving Lord who desires us!"

In Greenville, music will be led by Scott England. England was born in Chicago, Illinois, and found his home in Atlanta, at an early age. With three bands, six albums, numerous recording productions, frequent performances, multiple accolades, and over a decade of preparation under his belt, England is slowly but surely loving his way into the people's hearts all across the globe.

Dove Award winning artist Seth Condrey, along with England, Ted Rastatter from Ohio [who recently released his first album,] plus six or more artists will lead the community in corporate worship on the Atlanta stage. Worship will be diversified and a selection of multi-cultural music will be highlighted; among those, Spanish.

Throughout the night, pastors and leaders from the community will be leading attendees in prayer and reading scripture. The evening's program also consists of prayer circles
