Celebrating Worship on the Square II, October 25, 2008 **Area Churches Continue to Cross Denominational Lines** **for an Evening of Worship**

Atlanta, GA October 10, 2008 - A Saturday event called "Worship on the Square" is the combined efforts of various churches in Metro Atlanta for the purpose of pursuing Christian unity. Volunteers, staff, and churchgoers will converge on the Marietta Square at 4 Depot St NE, Marietta GA 30060 to demonstrate the love of God in a visible way.

"Worship on the Square" will not highlight one church or organization over another; rather it will seek to unite churches under the common bond of Jesus Christ. The night will be comprised of times of prayer for the community, interspersed with uplifting music. Numerous charitable organizations will be represented and attendees will have opportunity to learn more about volunteer opportunities within the community, nation, and globe.

The day's event is free to all and will be held from 7:00 pm to 10:00 pm rain or shine. Event creator, Debra Black insures that churches, charitable organizations, and herself agree their personal agendas are second place to the over arching theme of unity. "The community needs to see a united body of Christ," says Black. "This event is not about our own interests, it is about God's dream for His people, to unite for His name."

This is the second event for Black who gives God the glory and expects to see a lot of people coming out to attend. "Worship on the Square" was created to provide a gathering place and atmosphere of worship for people. The focus of the organization is to unite and encourage fellow believers to live a daily life of worship to the Lord, as so desired from the Lord in John 17:20-26. "Our prayer is that this won't be just another "worship event," where people come, feel like they experienced worship, got their fill and they are good till the next one. Our prayer is that this will be life changing! That we will be encouraged as believers to be bold about the truth we know and hold dear; that we will act and live our lives in complete worship to our Abba Father. We want to encourage the body to be unified together for His cause, and know what it means to be "doers of the word, not just hearers. That all men will know that we are His disciples who serve a living, active, loving Lord who desires us!"

The music will be led by two different worship leaders Matt Vaughan from Atlanta, and Ohio-resident Ted Rastatter. Along with their bands, each will be leading separate parts of the program. Throughout the night pastors from involved churches will be leading attendees in prayer and reading scripture. The evening's program also consists videos of God's work within the different ministries represented.
